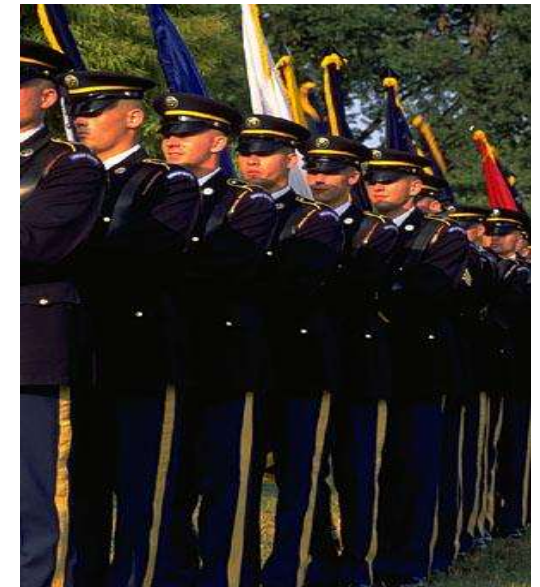

# New Hope Programs supporting our Community

## *“Kids Back-to-School” Program*

Families with children ages 6-12 years of age may register each calendar year (before August 1<sup>st</sup>), to receive FREE school supplies for their child. Supplies will be allocated per school requirements and age of the child. An original Birth Certificate must be provided to staff when picking up the school supplies.

## *“Christmas for Kids” Program*

Each year, New Hope Community Services of America will provide children Christmas gifts from Santa Claus. Parents need to apply at our office during the month of October, providing staff with five gift items the child desires. Gifts will be available for pick-up Christmas week.

## *“Wish Upon A Star” Program*

When a child, ages 1-17 are diagnosed with a terminal illness, the individual may receive a special wish. Talk direct with a staff member for more information about this program and the process in which the program operates.
